

BYLAW NO. 18/85

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF GIBBONS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PREVENTION OF FIRECRACKERS AND FIREWORKS AND DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF GIBBONS.

WHEREAS, under authority of and pursuant to Section 156 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Town of Gibbons, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The sale of firecrackers or fireworks are prohibited to be sold to person(s) under the age of 18 years.
2. The firing off of firecrackers or fireworks within the boundaries of the Town of Gibbons is prohibited unless permission is received from Council.
3. The firing or discharging of any type of gun, air pistol, air gun or firearms is prohibited within the boundaries of the Town of Gibbons.
4. Any person found violating the above is guilty of an offence.
5. Every person who contravenes this Bylaw or any part thereof is guilty of an offence and liable to summary conviction to
 - a) imprisonment for a term of not more than six months.
 - b) a fine of not more than \$2500.00.
 - c) to a fine and imprisonment
6. Bylaw No. 137 is hereby repealed.
